# **Stephen T. Kennedy Joins VoiceViewer Technologies, Inc.**

BANNOCKBURN, IL, January 15, 2006—Stephen T. Kennedy of Lake Forest, IL, has joined VoiceViewer Technologies, Inc. (VVT), a pioneering technology company developing innovative speech-recognition tools for improving the productivity of day-to-day business processes. Founded by CEO Michael G. Petera, a Wyoming entrepreneur and multiple patent holder in crystal display systems for mobile technology, VVT is the first company to integrate interactive speech-recognition, wireless communication, and innovative technologies with customer-driven application software for the healthcare industry. Its VoiceViewer® tool, a handheld wireless device, uses speech-recognition to facilitate the capture and documentation of patient data for hospitals, long-term care facilities, clinics, and physicians. It enables caregivers to enter patient information at the point of care—simply by talking—and allows them to upload it into a computer to automatically complete forms and charts.

Prior to joining VVT, Kennedy spent more than 18 years as a venture capital investor, business and technology executive, and entrepreneur. He has been involved in founding and managing a number of highly successful technology startups, including Siimpel, an optics and MEMS company that designs and builds devices for mobile communications. Previously, Kennedy served as CEO of EpiWorks, an advanced material semiconductor spinout from the University of Illinois, and as CFO for Picolight, a leading photonic transceiver company based in Boulder, CO.
